



## SPR Undergraduate Prevention Science Training Program Call for Applications

**Application Deadline: March 8, 2024**

- 1. Program Description:** The Society for Prevention Research (SPR) is seeking applicants to a 1-year program to support aspiring prevention scientists with a focus on increasing underrepresented populations in prevention science research. Through this program, undergraduate students will receive an introduction to prevention science and how to pursue a career in prevention science through virtual workshops and [SPR 2024 conference](#) attendance.
- 2. Eligibility:** Eligible students must have completed a minimum of two years post-secondary education and meet the definition of an underrepresented minority, as defined by [NIH](#). A SPR member must sponsor the student's application to the program and both the member and student may receive financial support to attend the SPR conference.

This is a rigorous and competitive program that has the goal of assisting underrepresented undergraduate students in pursuing a career in prevention science. This is a 1-year program, and it is expected that scholars remain actively engaged for the full length of the program.
