### **Program Description**

The Society for Prevention Research (SPR) is seeking applicants for a 1-year program to support aspiring prevention scientists with a focus on increasing underrepresented populations in prevention science research. Through this program, undergraduate students will receive an introduction to prevention science and how to pursue a career in prevention science through virtual workshops and [SPR 2026 conference](#) attendance.

### **Eligibility**

Eligible students must have completed a minimum of two years post-secondary education and meet the definition of an underrepresented minority, as previously defined by NIH (see google form application for more information). A SPR member must sponsor the students' application to the program, and both the member and student may receive financial support to attend the SPR conference.

This is a rigorous and competitive program that has the goal of assisting underrepresented undergraduate students in pursuing a career in prevention science. This is a 1-year program, and it is expected that scholars will remain actively engaged for the full length of the program.
